Student Fees

For all students that are accepted (placement at WSD has been determined) at WSD, student fees are collected during Registration Day and various points in time during the school year.

Be prepared, upon registration or enrollment/acceptance to WSD, to pay the following accounts (cash or check). This fee is non-refundable and pays for items, such as those listed below, which are not provided by state funds:

Offset Field Trips and Lock-In Expenses
Wisconsin Times Subscription
Student-Parent Handbook Publication
Class Project Materials
Academic Reinforcers – PBIS Items
Hearing Aid Batteries
Presenters and Guest Speakers

Total: \$115.00 (\$57.50 for PK & K students) *payable to WSD*

(if you are unable to pay the fee all at once – the business office will work with you to arrange payments)

Spending Money:

Suggested amounts vary by age of child.
Recommend sufficient amount for 2 to 4 weeks

Total: suggested a minimum of \$20.00 *payable to WSD*

Note: WSD does not encourage the practice of giving younger children cash to keep in the dormitory. The Business Office will distribute cash to Child Care Counselors or older students from the office.

Fines and Debt:

overdue/lost/damage library materials
damaged or lost textbooks
damaged property

Payable at registration or any time during the year that you are invoiced.

We encourage you to pay these fees via mail, prior to Registration Day. This will help with a smoother registration process. You can send the fees with your registration/medical forms.
